

New Guidelines and Policies for Students Entering the ABC Bayou Campus

- All Students will enter the campus on the southside of building between the two classroom buildings.
- All Students will be required to stop at a Temperature Check-point, to enter the classroom building and the welding shop.
- If your temperature is equal to or greater than 100.4 you will not be allowed to enter the building or attend class that night.
- Upon entering the classroom building, either wash your hands immediately, or use the hand sanitizer. Proper washing techniques are to wash your hands for at least 20 seconds (sing Happy Birthday at a normal pace twice).
- Once you enter the building you must remain in the building until all students have been temperature checked to enter the building. (Students make sure you have all your proper tools, materials, books and paper to start your class).
- If you arrive late for class you must remain in the hallway by your class and notify the instructor so that the instructor can call personnel to meet you in the hallway to take your temperature before entering the class
- All classroom desks are set 6' foot apart from each other and need to remain that way the entire class period.
- The doors on both the eastside of old classroom building and the old welding shop breakroom will be locked until 6:30pm. If there is an emergency you can push the paddle lever to exit the building.
