 3. Not a current or past ABC member at any other Chapter
 4. Commit to a GC or Subcontractor Category following a maximum of 2 years at the Start-up Contractor dues level

Definition of Member Constituents:

A **Contractor** is a person, a firm, or a corporation which is directly involved in building or construction

A **Supplier** is a person, firm, or corporation which is not responsible for on-site labor

An **Associate** is a person, firm, or corporation, which is neither a Contractor nor a Supplier, providing services to the construction industry, but not directly involved in construction; does not supply direct labor and/or materials on-site
